In addition, the transmittal shall contain an abstract, concisely stating the purpose of the question and the form of the ballot proposal.

§4-106(4) Within three days after the occurrence of a vacancy, the clerk is required to file with this office a certificate indicating the

vacancy and the position which is to be filled.
\$6-158(14) A vacancy occurring before September 20, in any Public Office, to be filled at a General Election, shall be filled at the NEXT GENERAL ELECTION.
